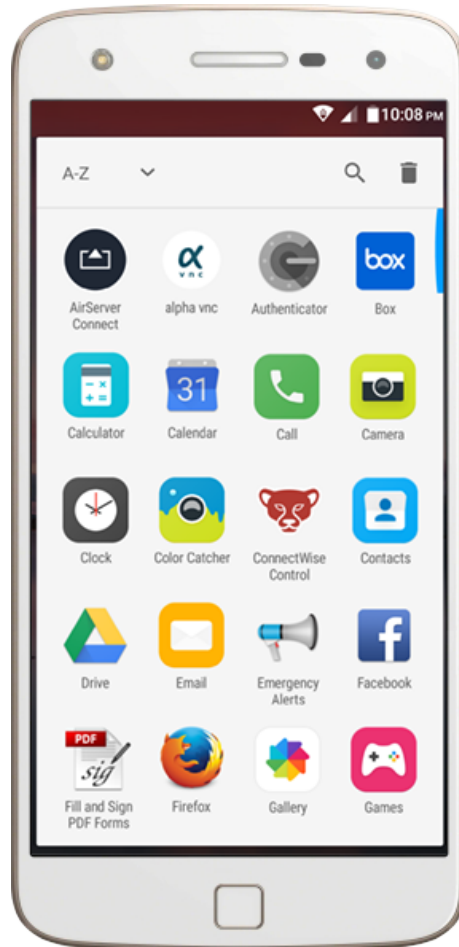

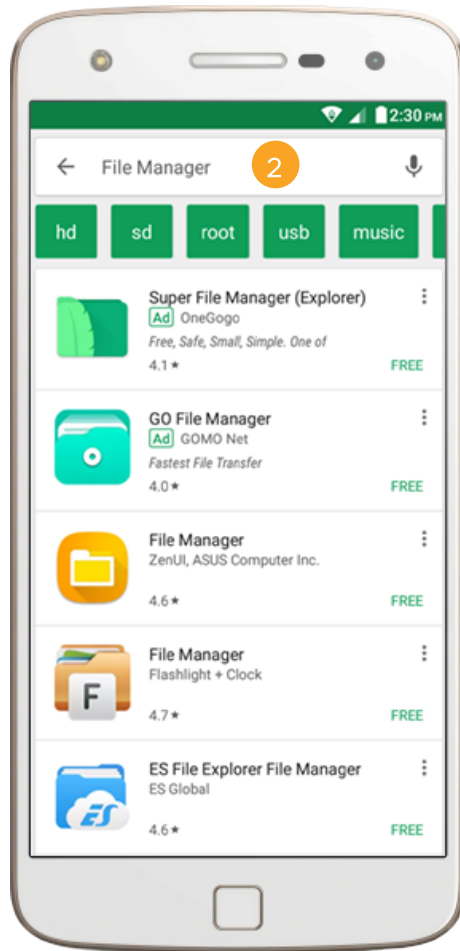

## Step 1: File Manager

Before installing “App Locker”, ensure you have a “File Manager” application installed on your device.



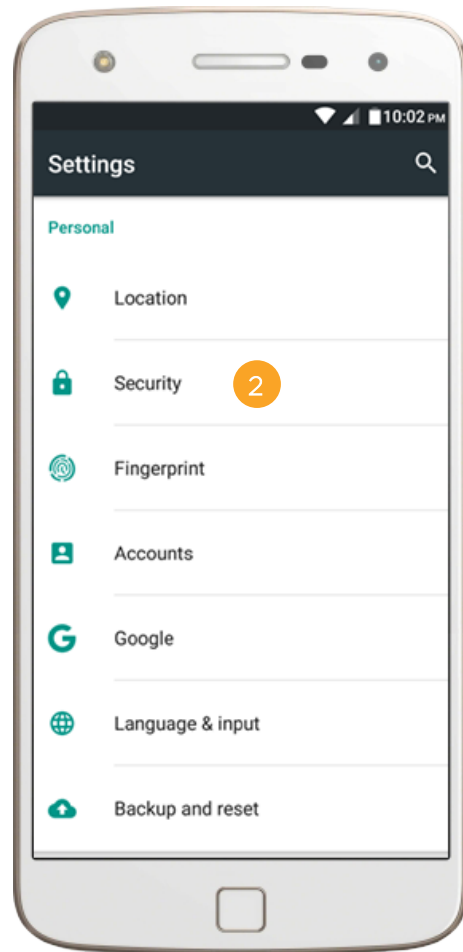
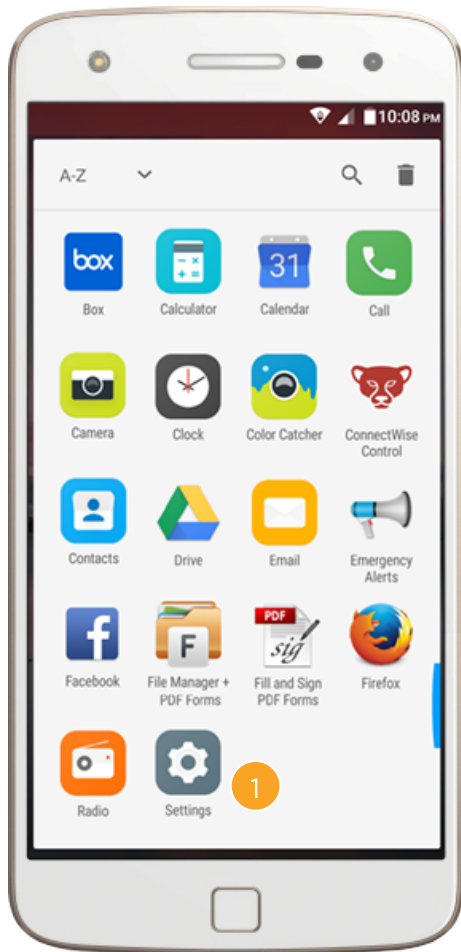
If you have a “File Manager” application installed, skip to Step 2. If not, go to the “Google Play Store” and search for “File Manager”. Select a “File Manager” application and install.

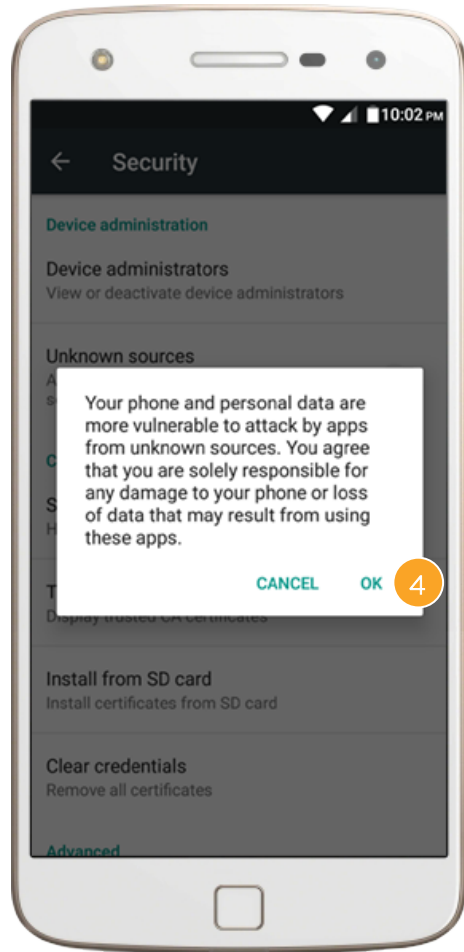
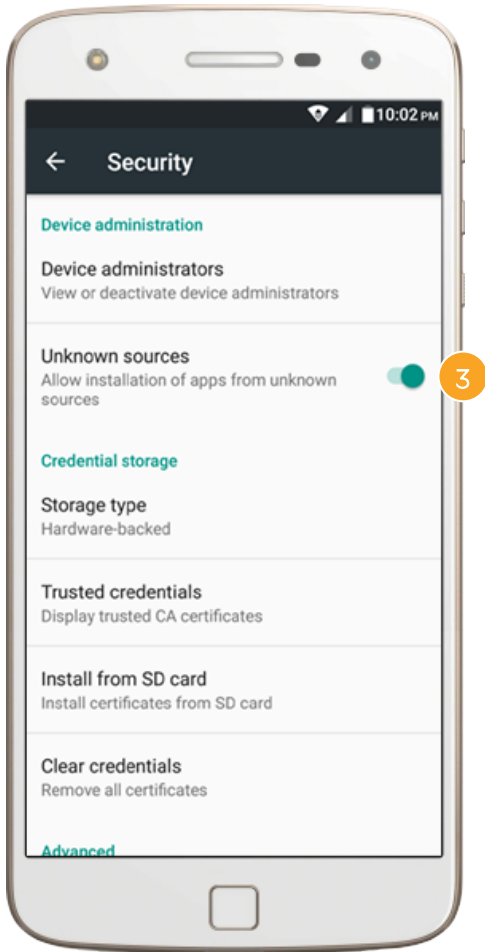




## Step 2: Device Security

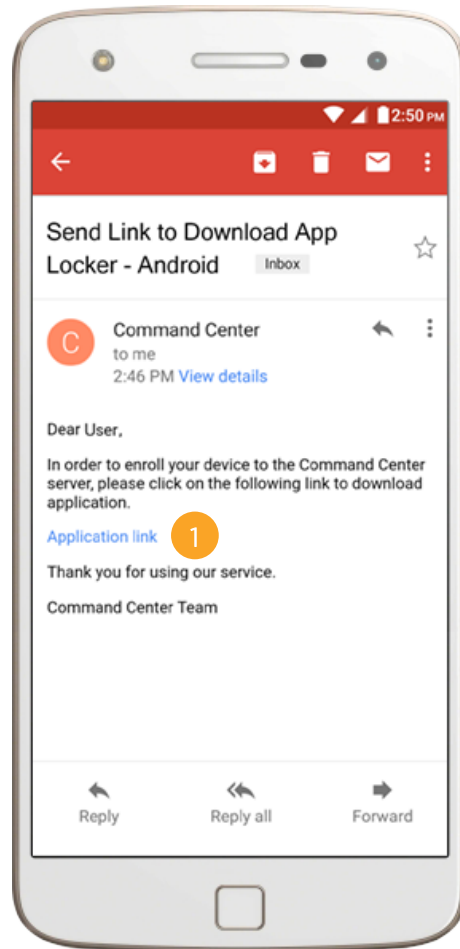
Before installing “App Locker”, temporarily enable apps to be installed from unknown sources. Go to “Settings” and select “Security”. Then turn on “allow installation of apps from unknown sources”.



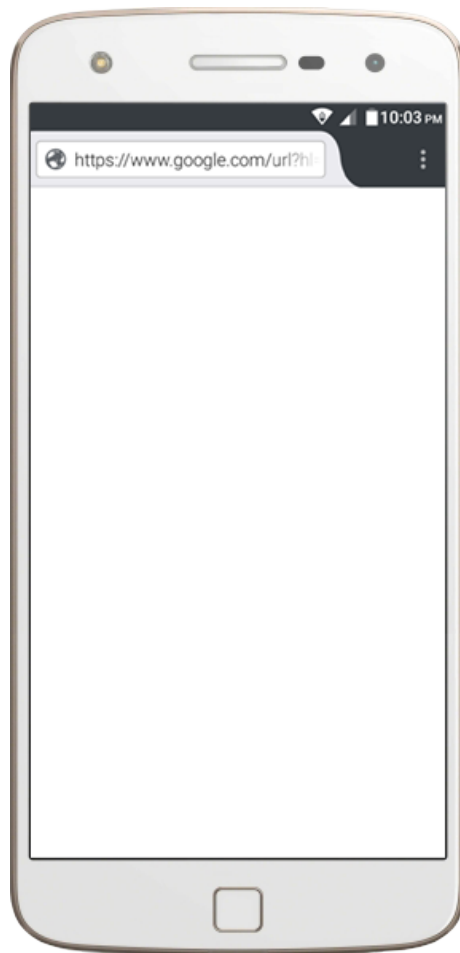
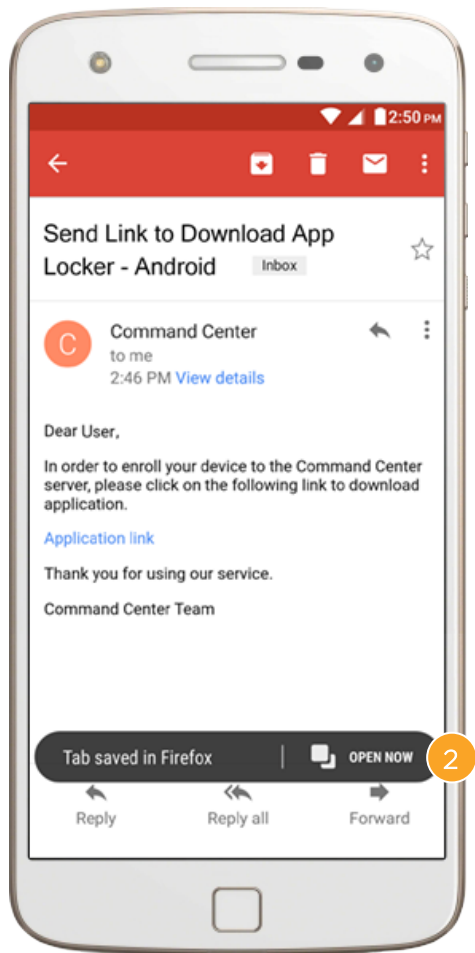


### Step 3: App Locker Installation

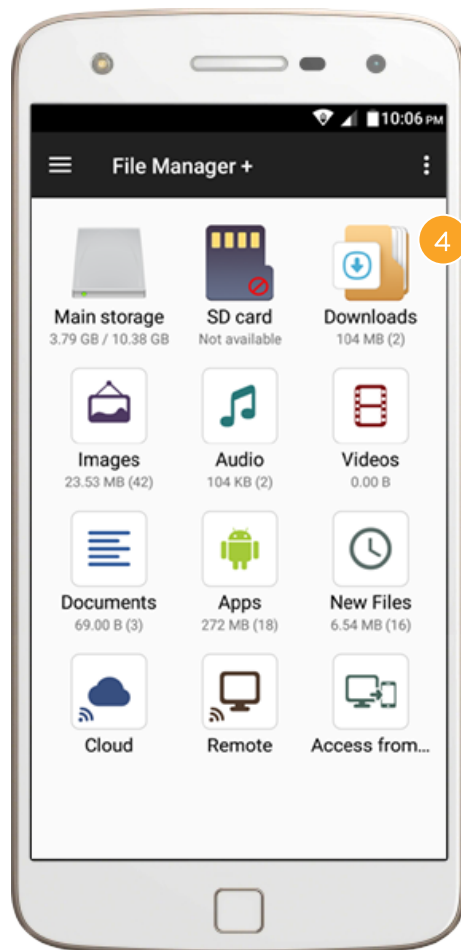
You should receive an email message from “Command Center” (if you cannot find the email in your inbox, be sure to check your spam folder). Tap on the “Application Link”:



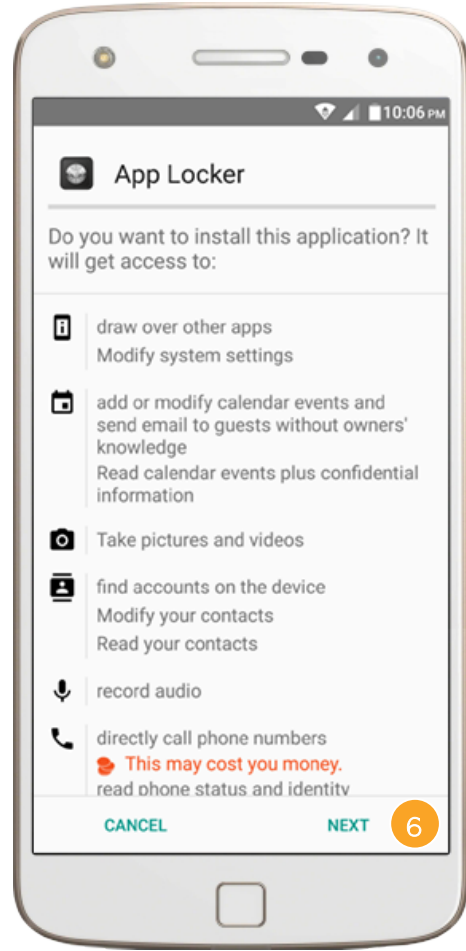
After tapping on the link, you should receive a notice about opening in your browser. Tap “Open Now where you will then be redirected to your browser”.

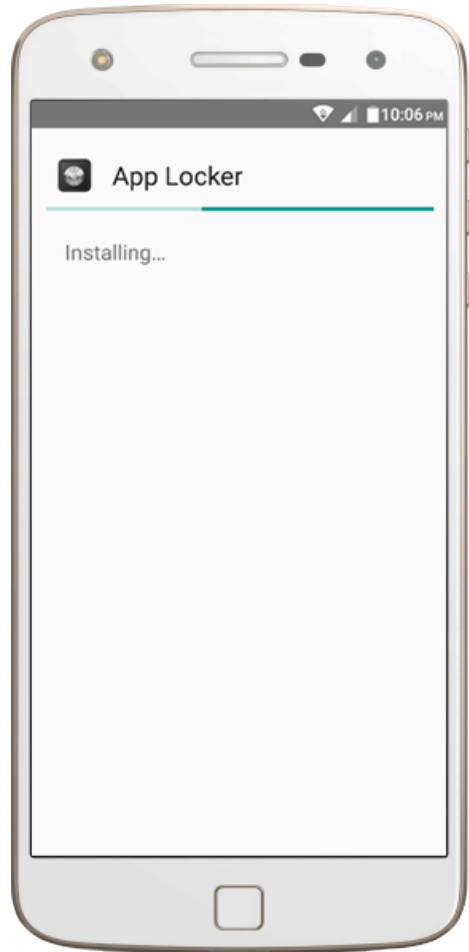
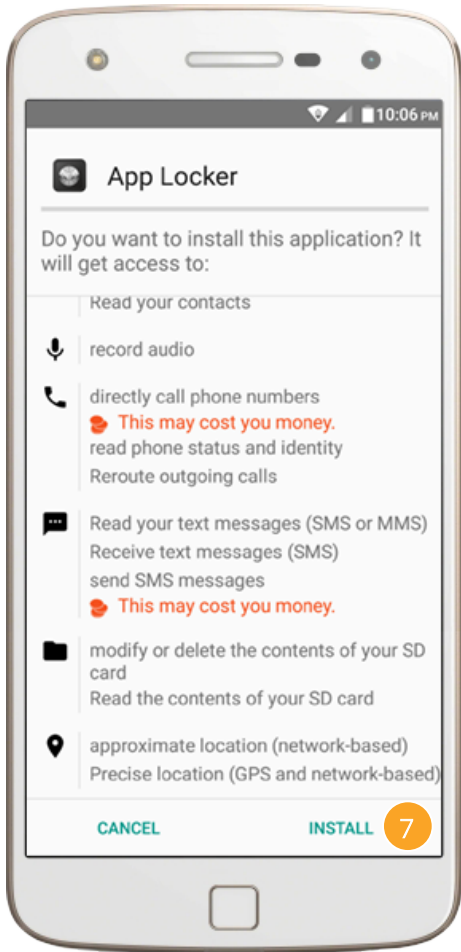


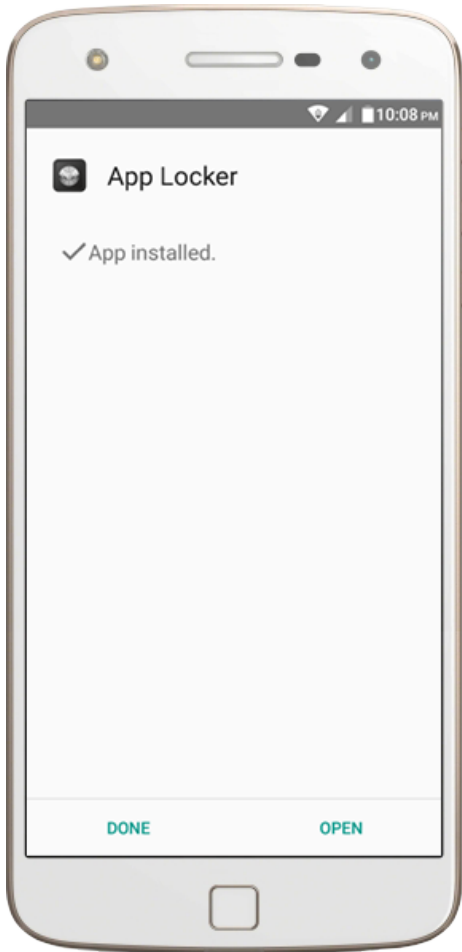
Now go to your “File Manager” application and check the “Downloads” folder.



There should be a file called “AppLocker.apk” or “MDMC.apk”. Tap on the file and you will be asked to confirm installation through a number of steps:

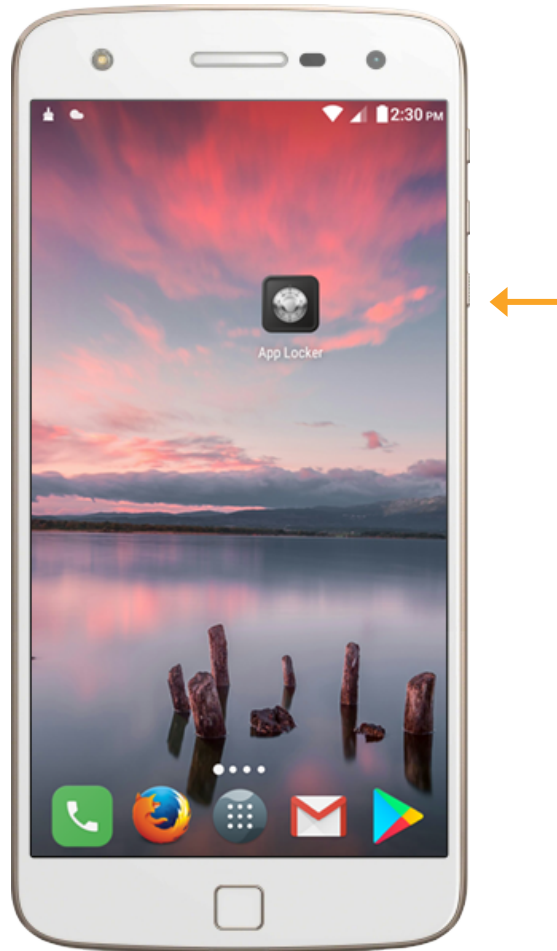




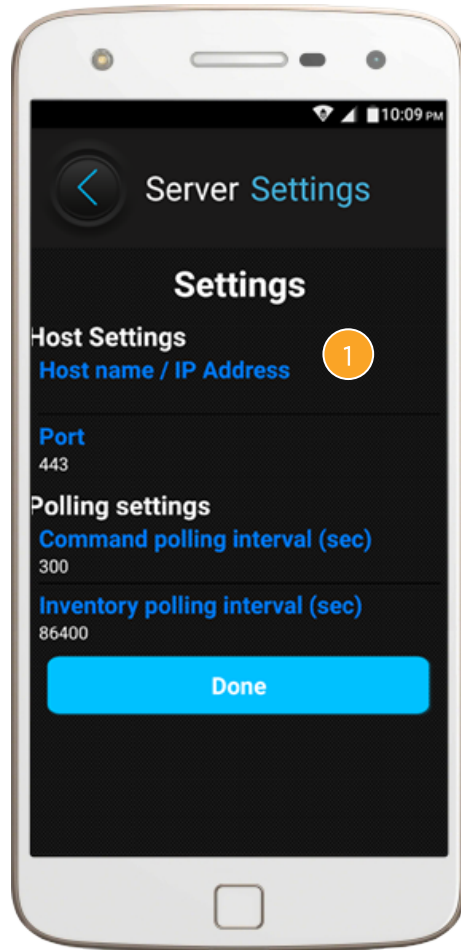


## Step 4: App Locker Server Settings

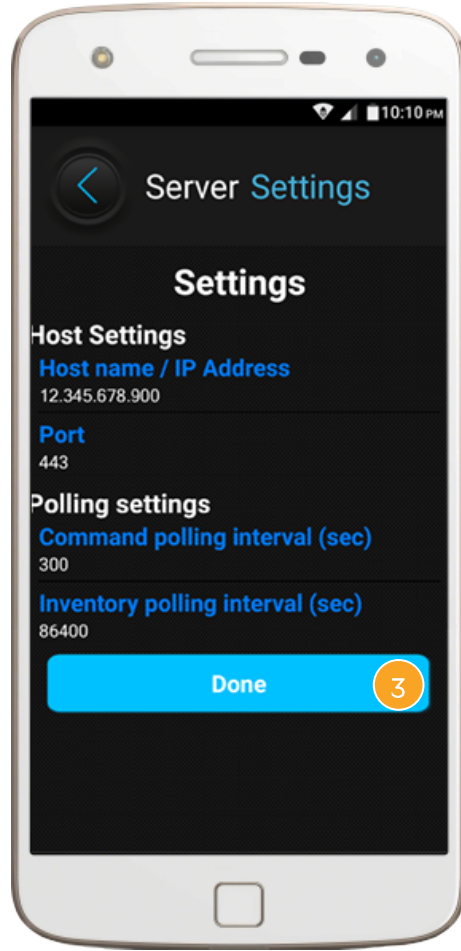
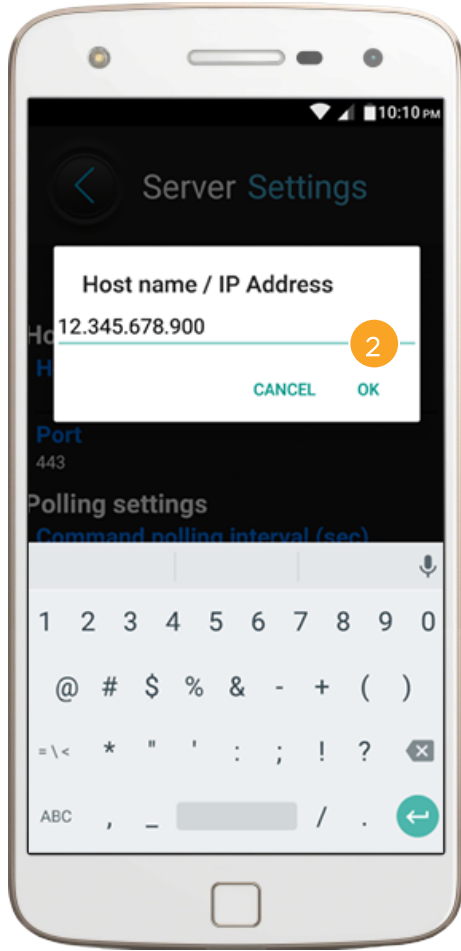
Tap on the App Locker icon.



When opening App Locker for the first time, you will be asked to setup your "Server Settings".

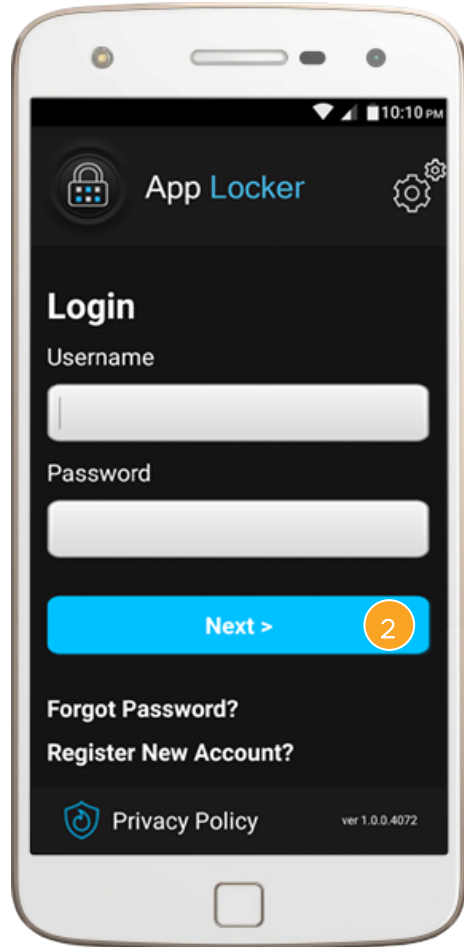
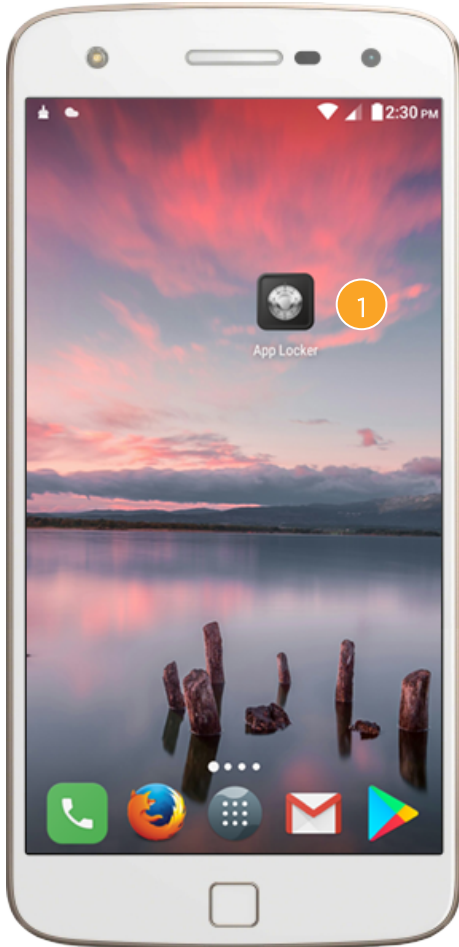


Tap on the “Host / IP Address” and enter the information provided by your Command Center Administrator.



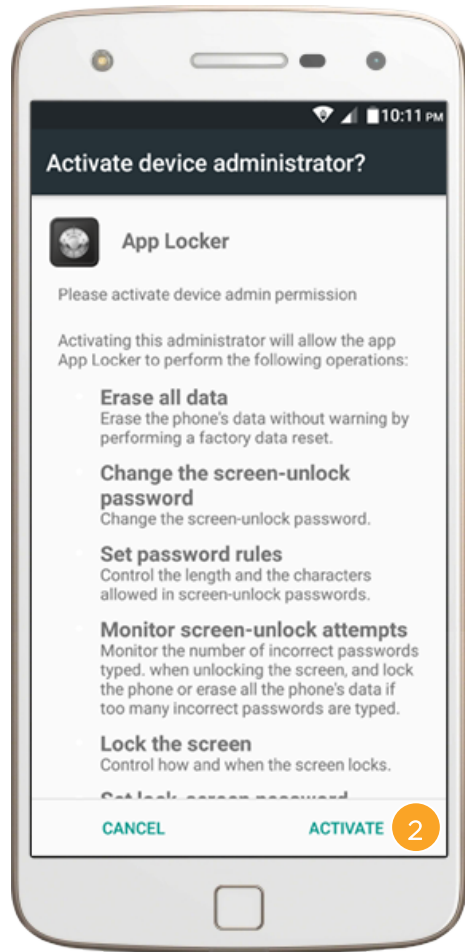
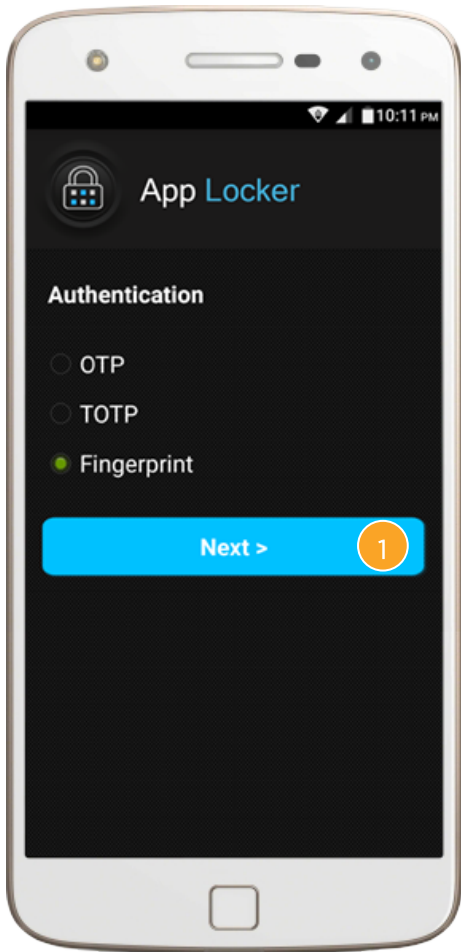
## Step 5: App Locker First Time Login

Tap on the “App Locker” icon, and then enter the “Username” and “Password” provided to you by your Command Center Administrator.

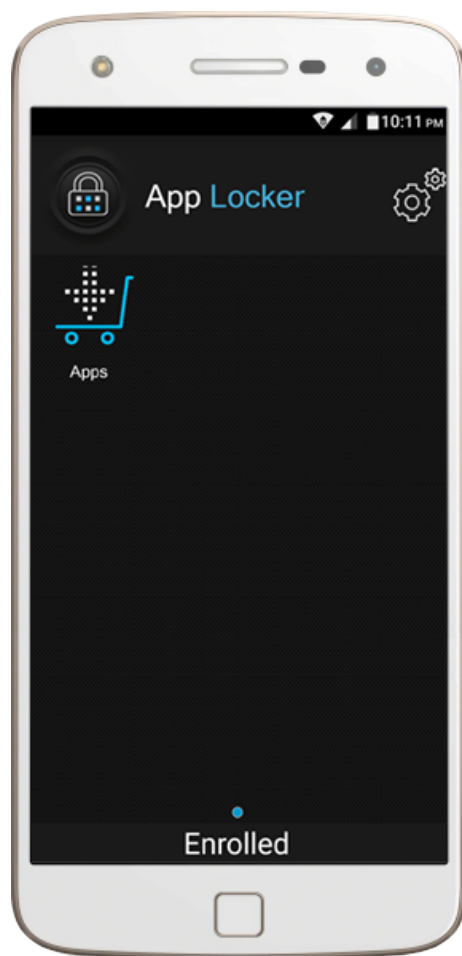


Select your preferred method of second factor authentication:

- OTP (One Time Password - email or sms)
- TOTP (Time One Time Password - Google Authenticator)
- Fingerprint



You will then enter the App Locker:

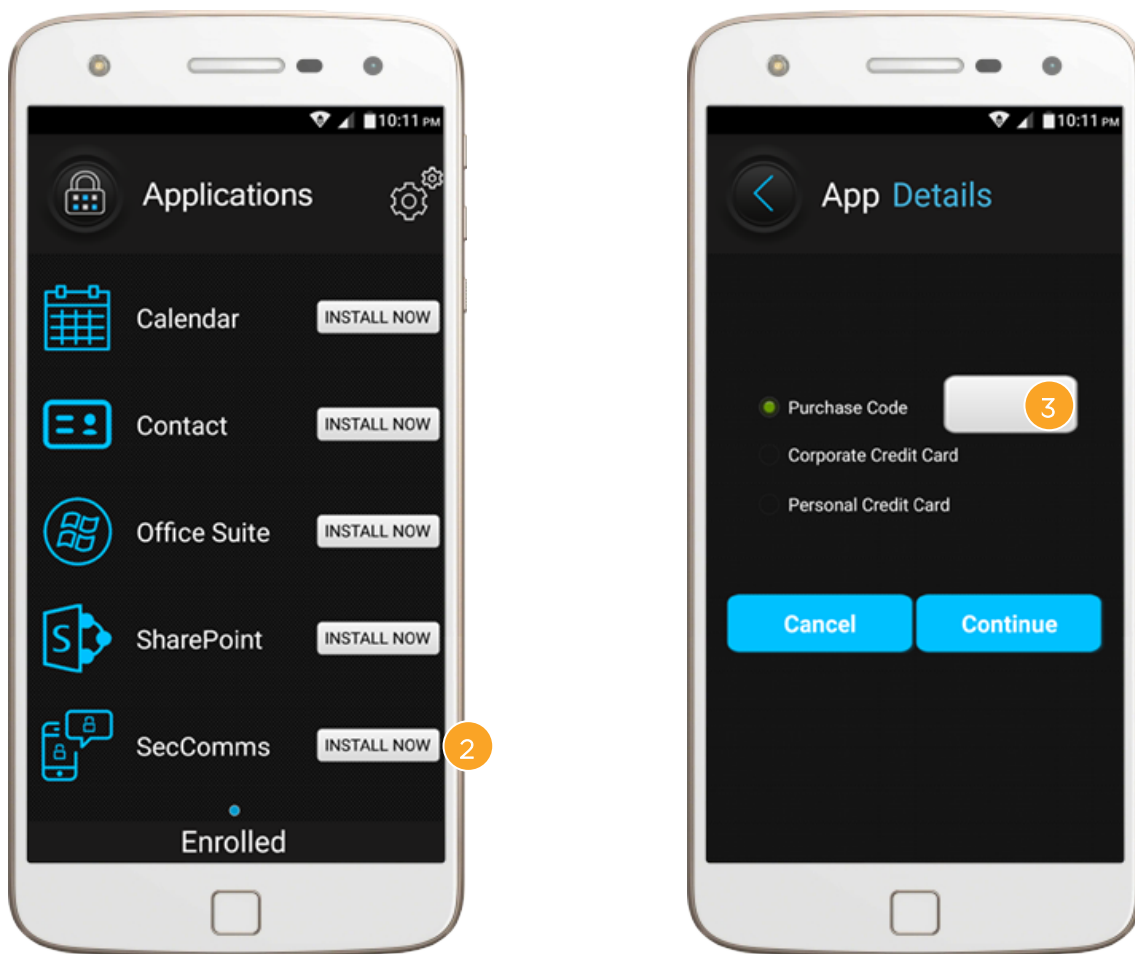


## Step 5: Install Apps in App Locker

Once logged in, tap on the “App”.



You will then be presented with a list of apps. Tap on your app of choice where you may need to enter a "Purchase Code" or "Credit Card" information. Purchase Codes are provided by your Command Center Administrators.



Once you enter purchase code or payment information (if required), your app will be installed in App Locker.
