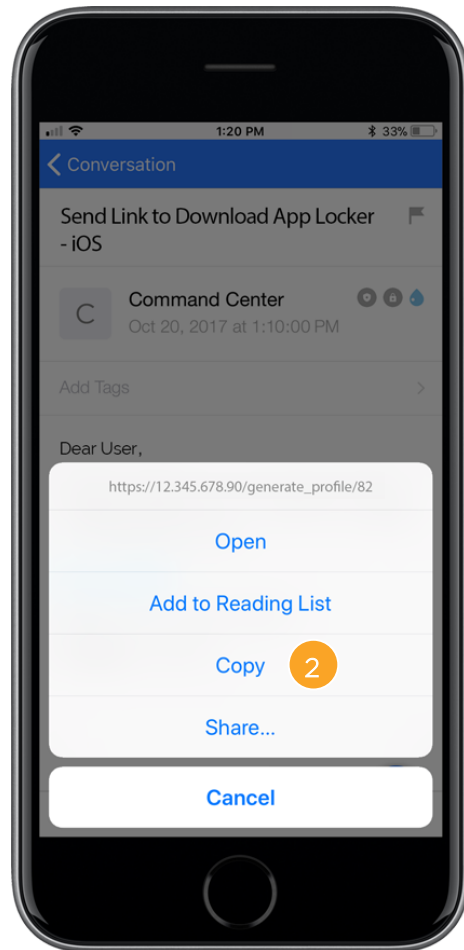
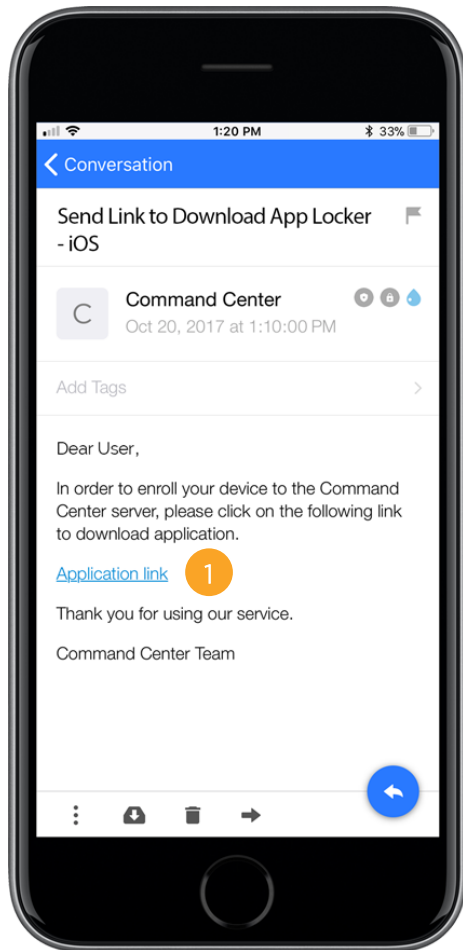

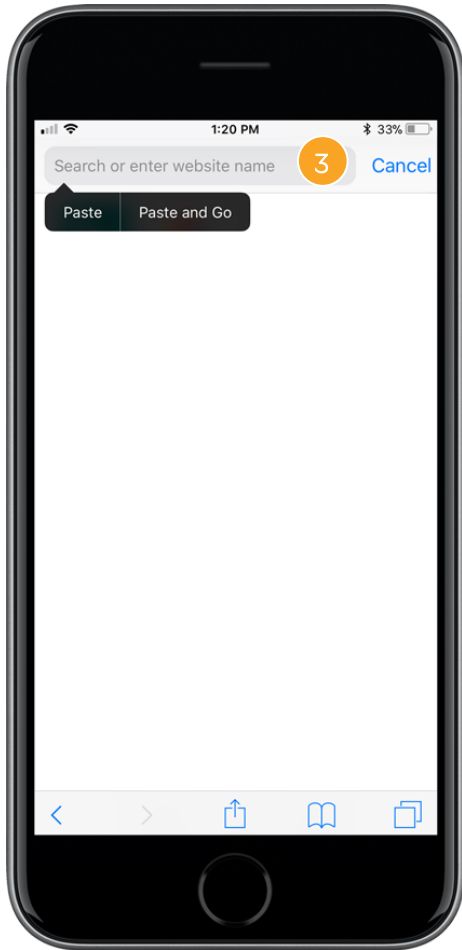

Install App Locker

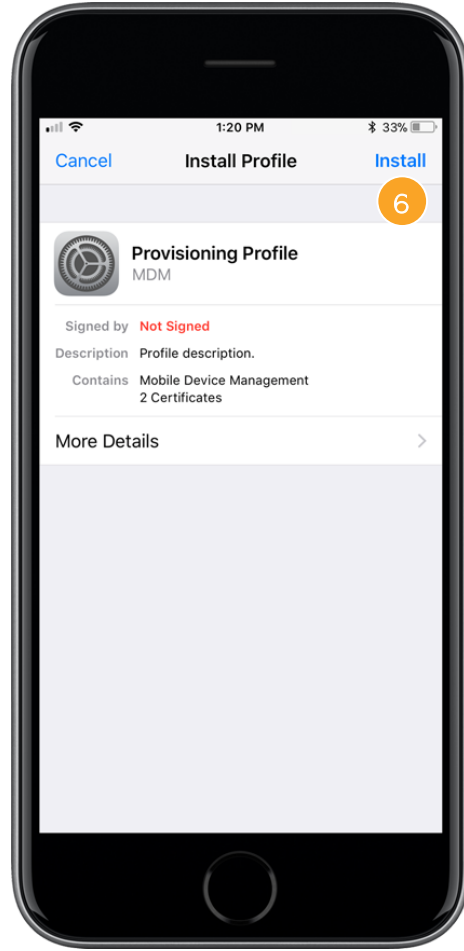
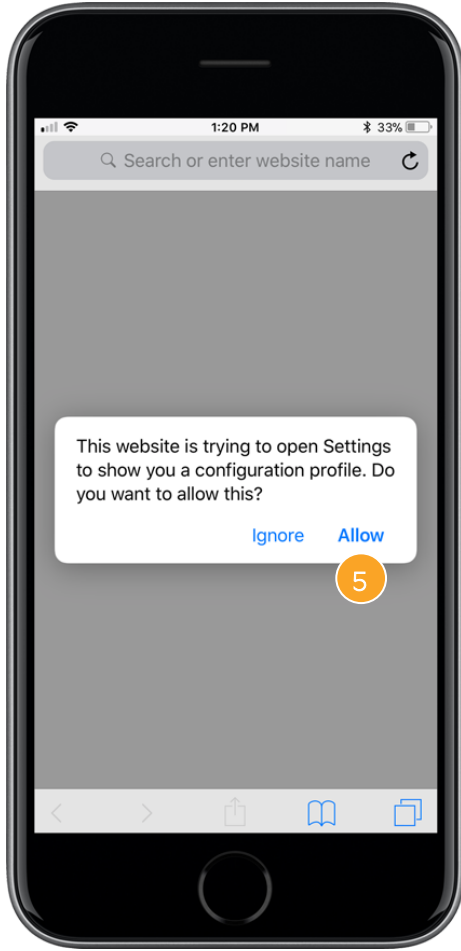
You should receive an email message from “Command Center” (if you cannot find the email in your inbox, be sure to check your spam folder). Tap and hold on the “Application Link” and then select “Copy”.



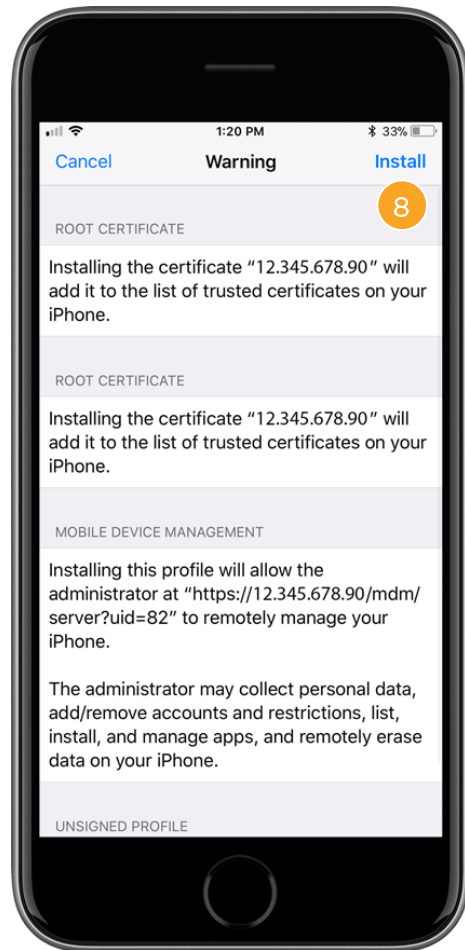
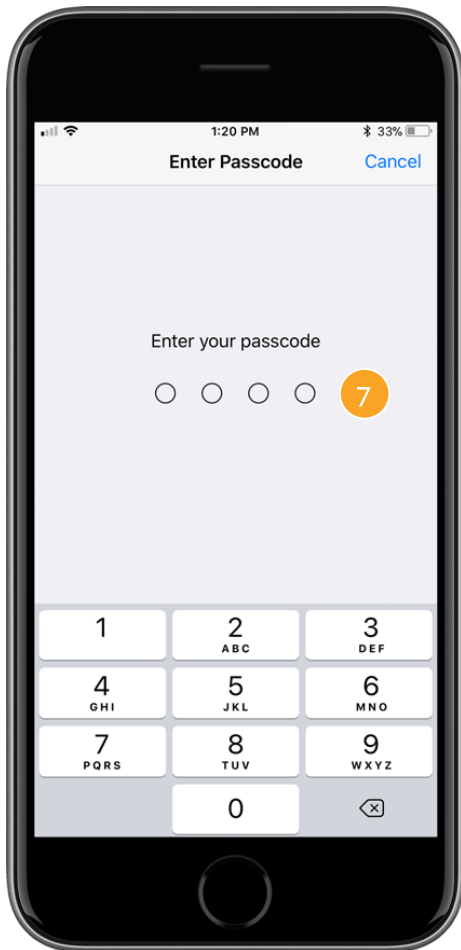
Open your "Browser". Tap and hold down in the URL entry field and select "Paste". Then tap "Go".



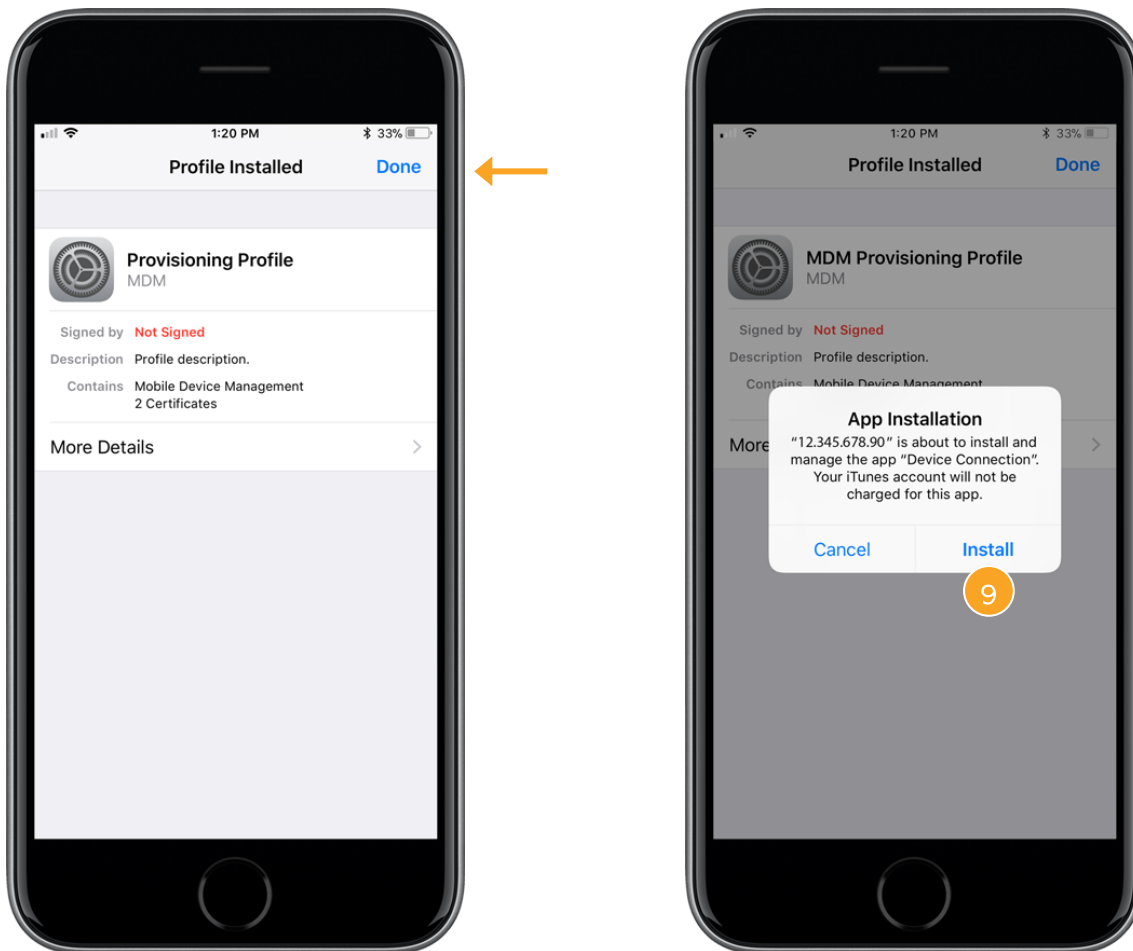
Next, you should receive a warning stating the website is trying to open Settings and install a configuration profile - select "Allow". You will then be asked to install a profile - select "Install".



You will be asked to enter your device's passcode and presented with a warning - select "Install".



You will then receive notice the profile is installed. Wait approximately 30 seconds, and you will then be presented with the notice to install the application - select "Install".

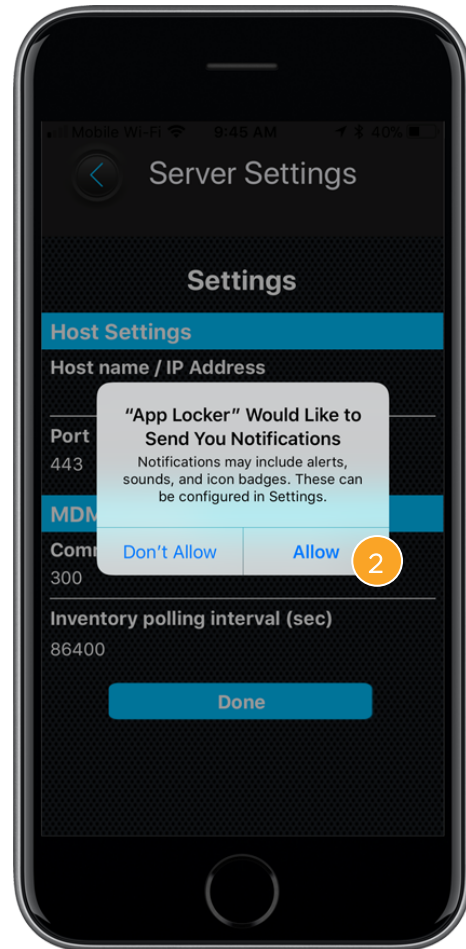


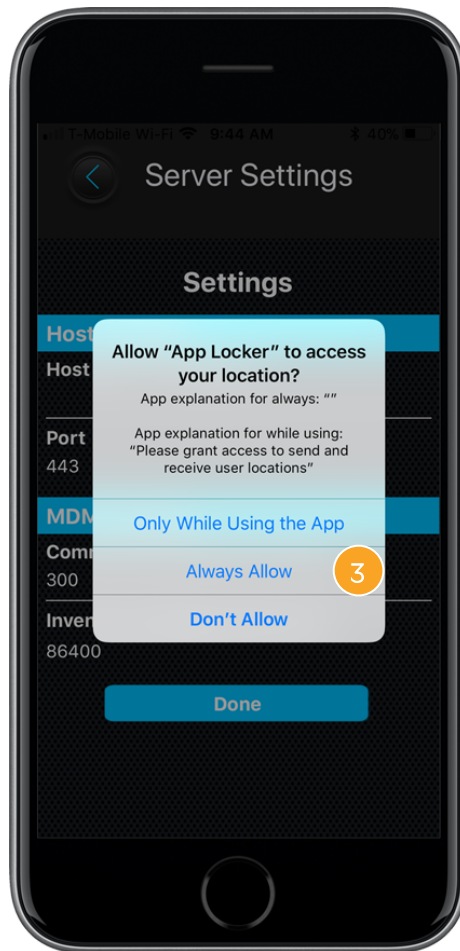
You will then notice App Locker loading until the process is complete.



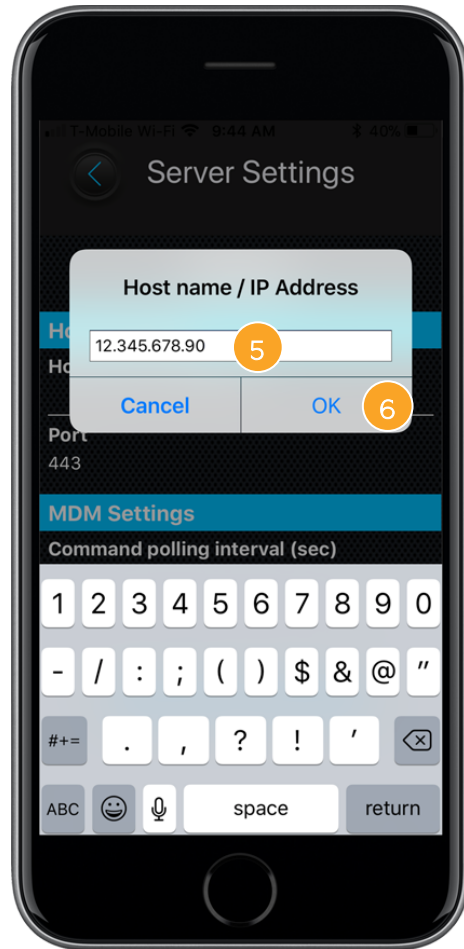
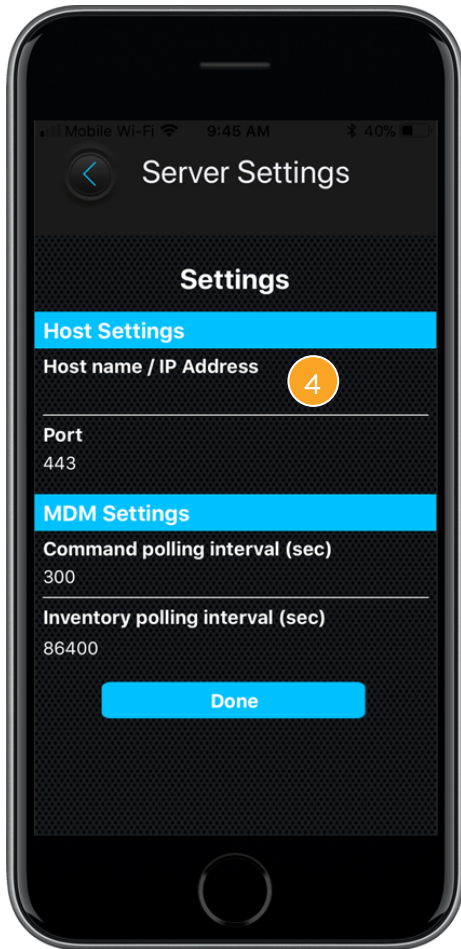
Open App Locker (First Time)

Tap the App Locker icon. Then accept some device notification and location permission settings.



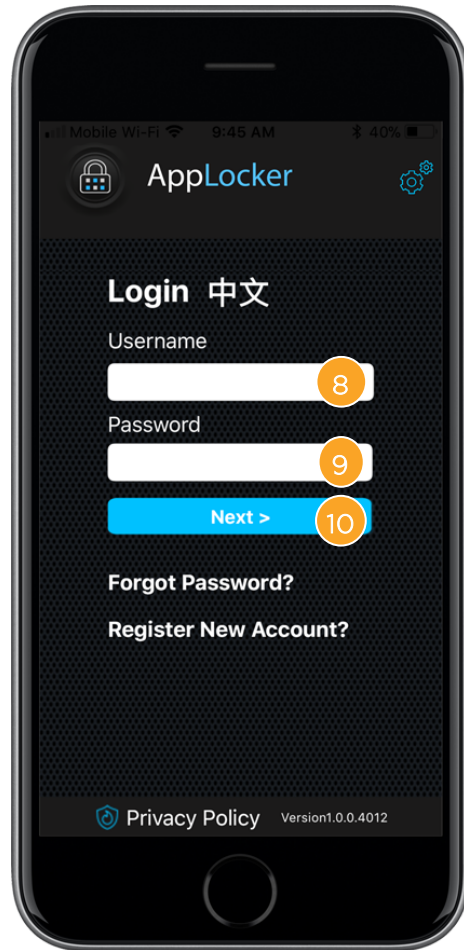
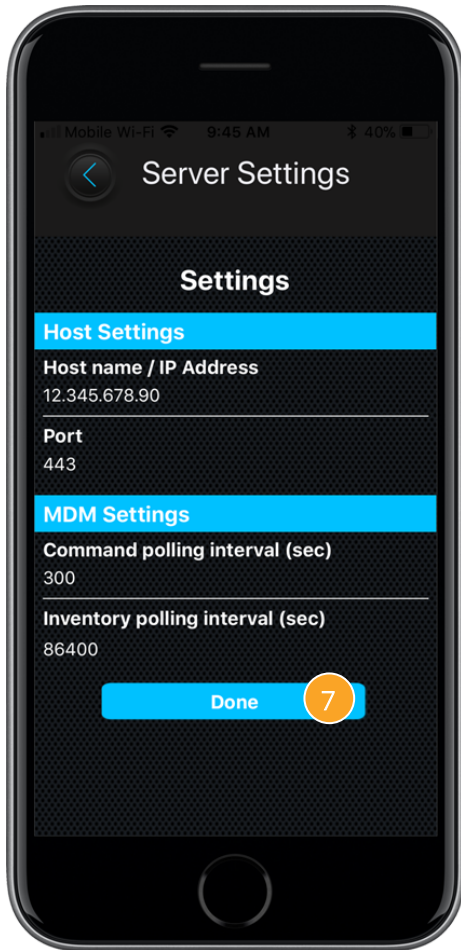


When opening App Locker for the first time, you will be asked to setup your “Server Settings”. Tap on the “Host / IP Address” and enter the information provided by your Command Center Administrator, then select “OK”.



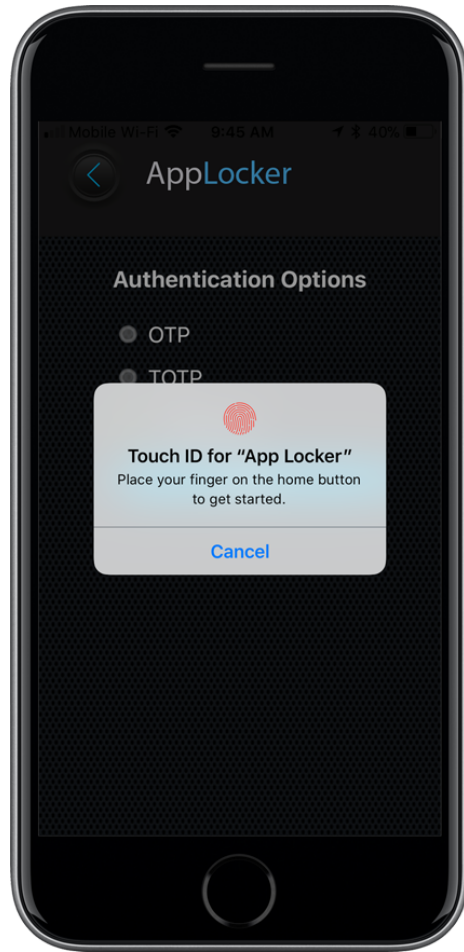
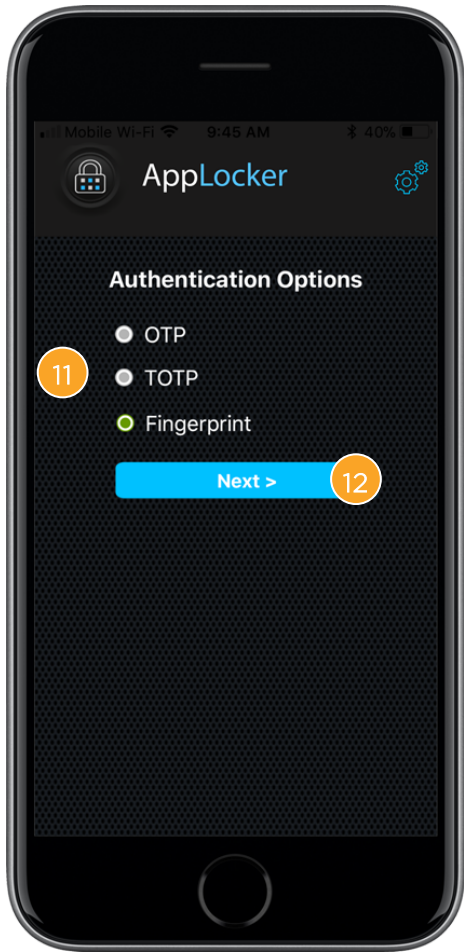
Once you have entered the correct Host Name / IP Address, select “Done”.

You will then be presented with the App Locker login screen. Enter your “Username” and “Password”, provided to you by your Command Center Administrator, then select “Next”.

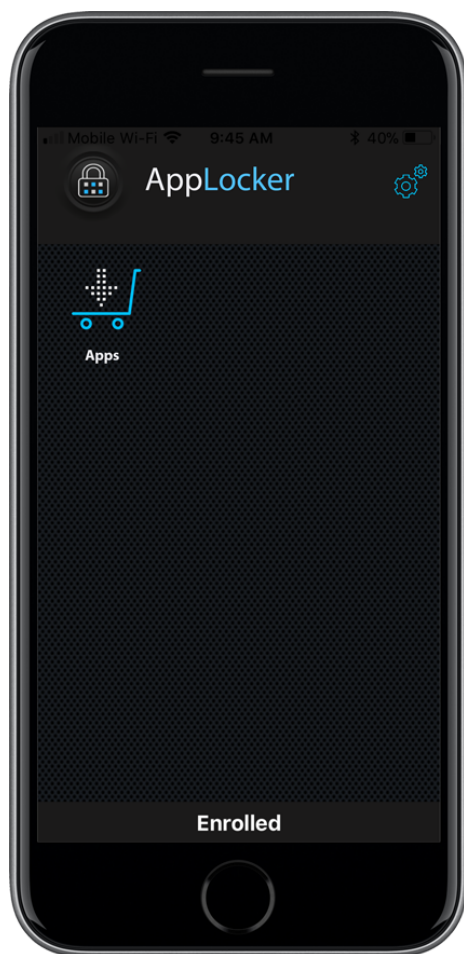


Select your preferred method of second factor authentication:

- Fingerprint

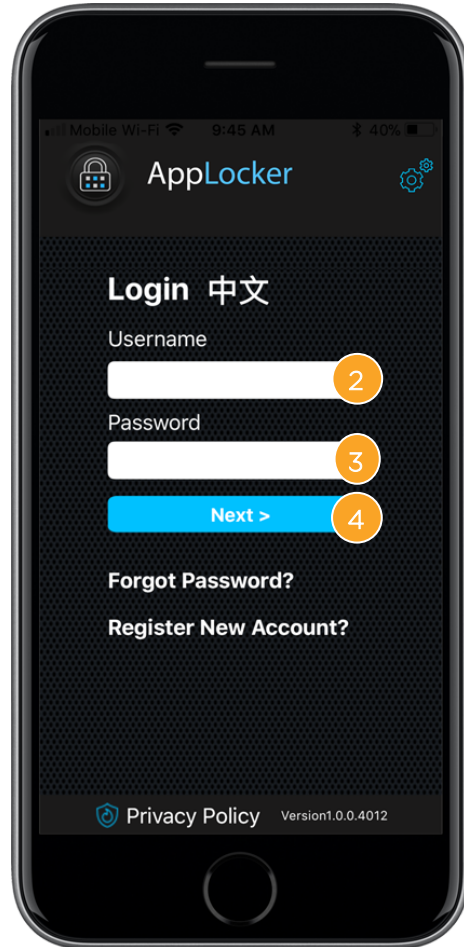


You will then enter the App Locker.



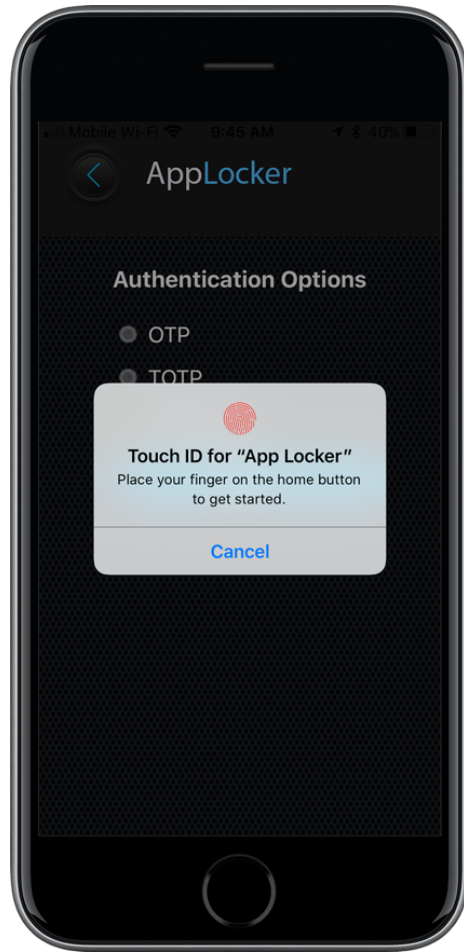
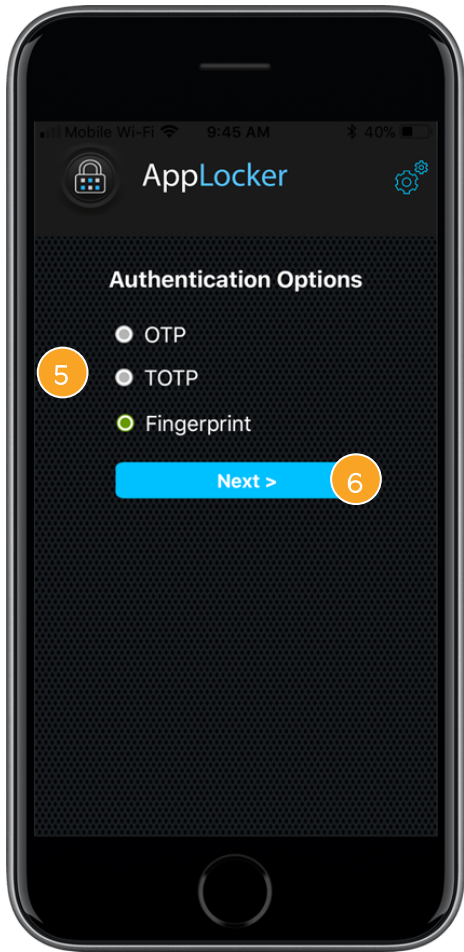
Open App Locker (Normal)

Tap the App Locker icon. Enter your username and password then select “Next”.

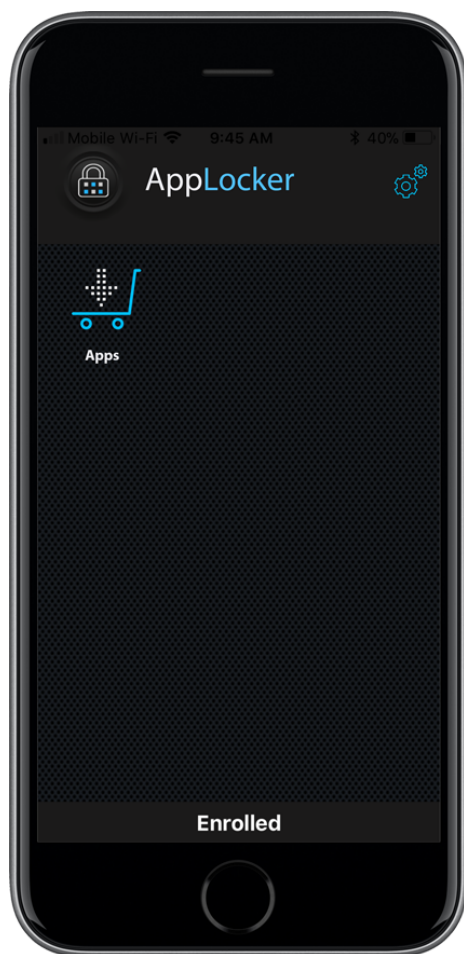


Select your preferred method of second factor authentication:

- Fingerprint

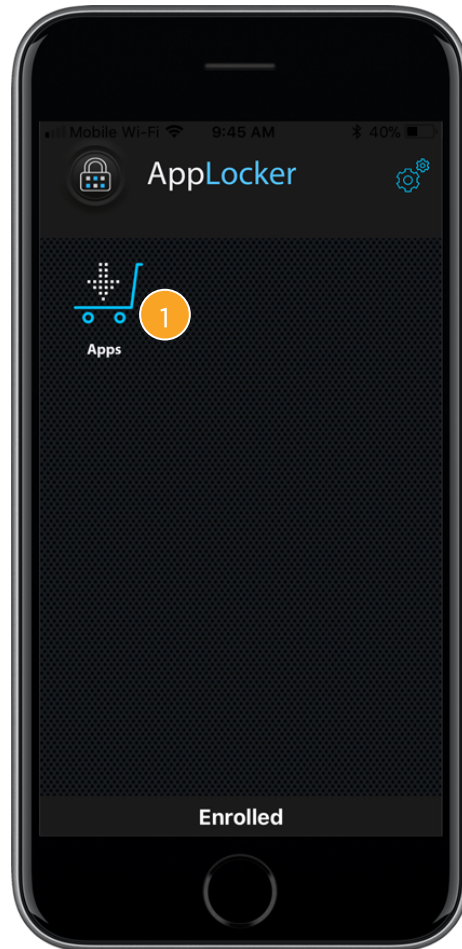


You will then enter the App Locker.

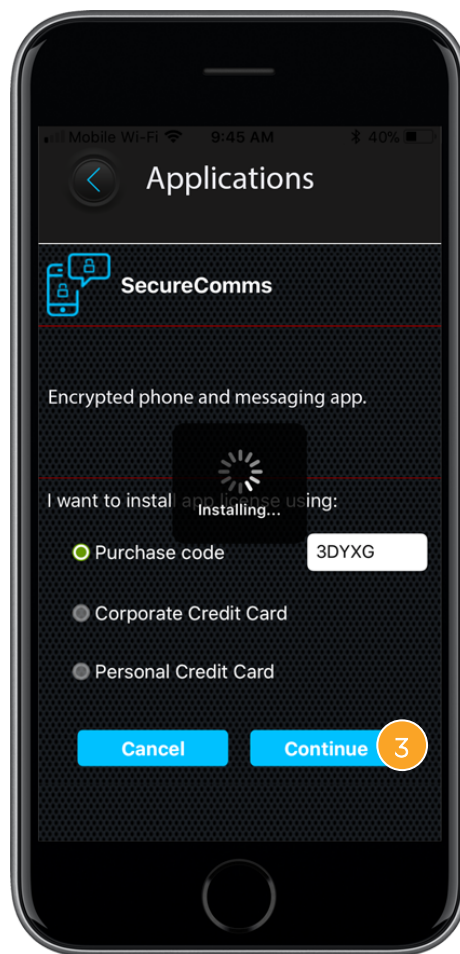
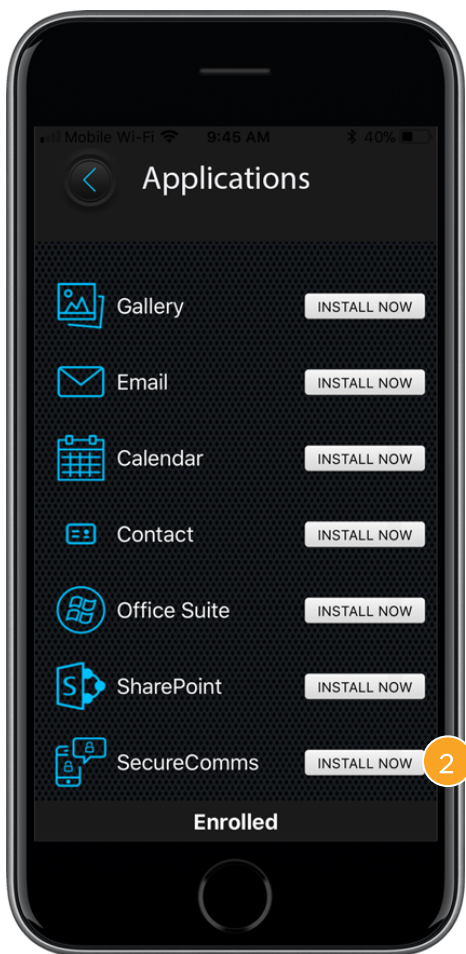


Install Apps in App Locker

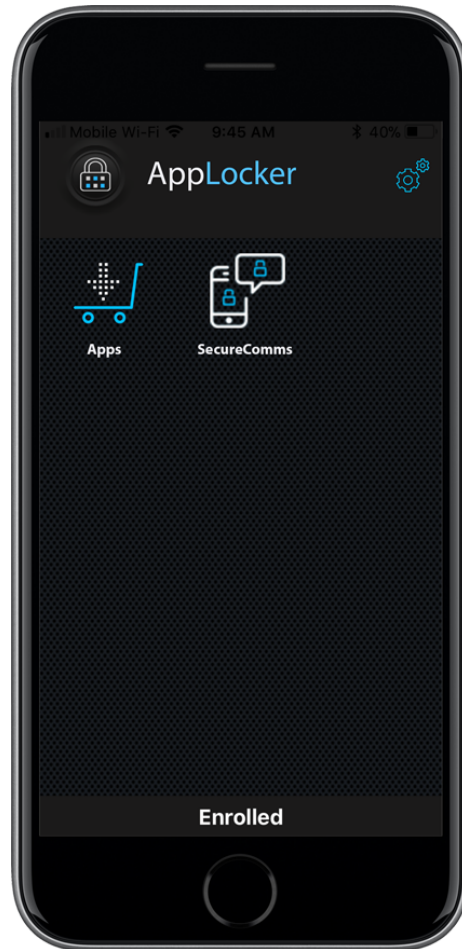
Log into App Locker, tap on the “Apps” icon.



You will then be presented with a list of apps. Tap on your app of choice where you may need to enter a "Purchase Code" or "Credit Card" information. Purchase Codes are provided by your Command Center Administrators.

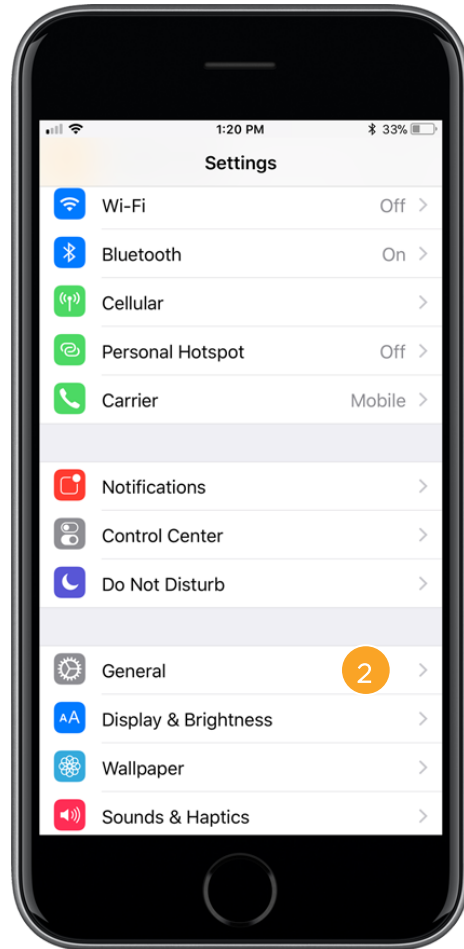


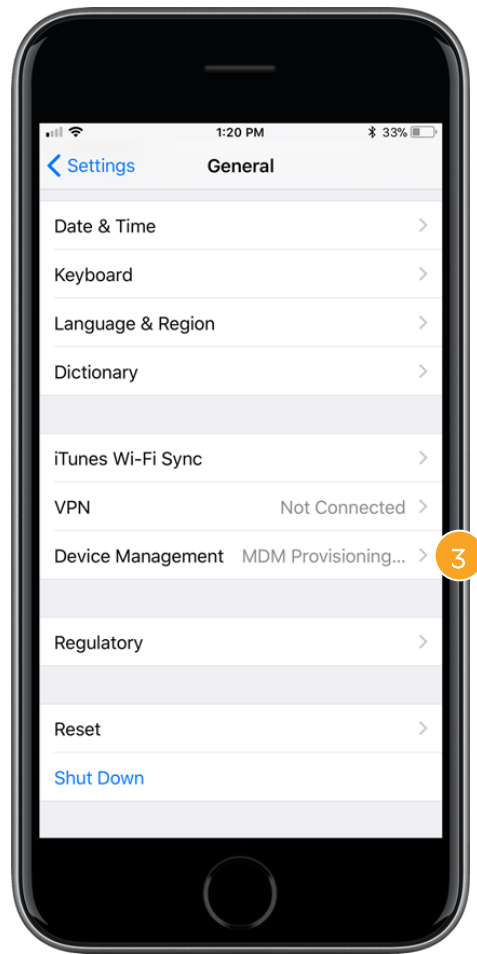
Once you enter purchase code or payment information (if required), your app will be installed in App Locker.



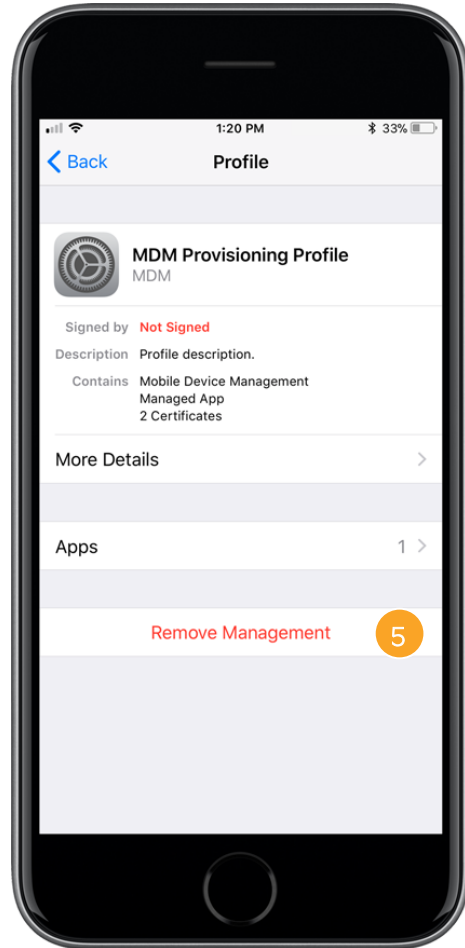
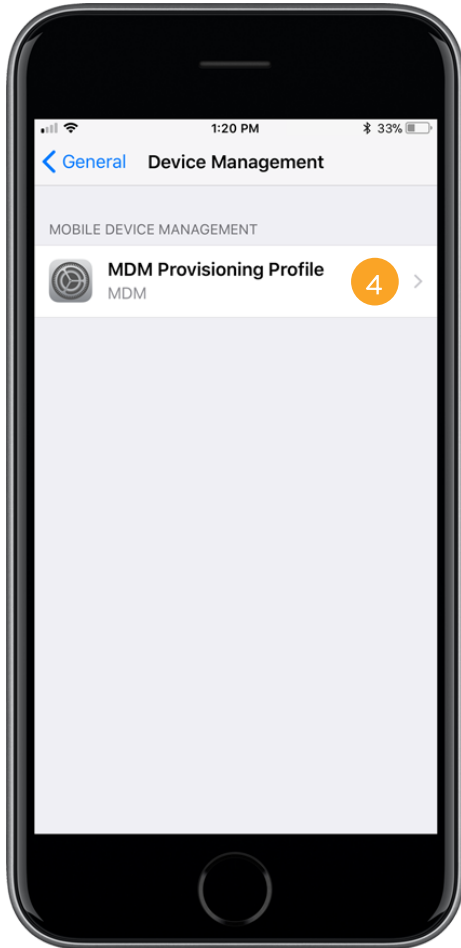
Uninstall App Locker

Go to Settings / General / Device Management.

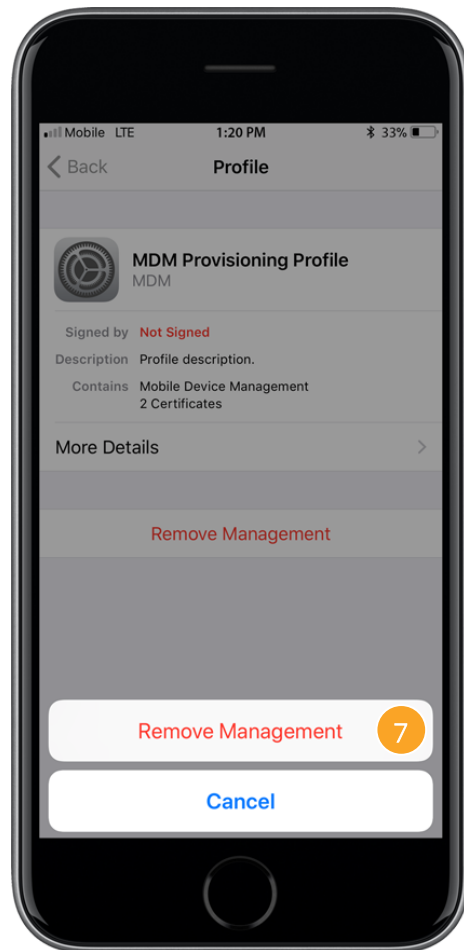
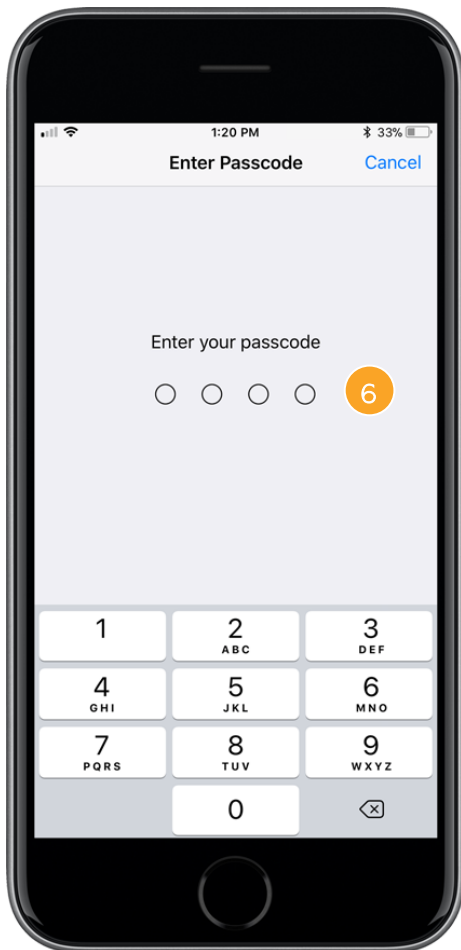




Tap on the MDM Provisioning Profile and then select Remove Management.



Enter your device Passcode and confirm Remove Management.
